## Worth remembering

Our blades seesaw !!!

As one blade moves up—the other will move down, a necessary motion for stable autorotation.

And this principle does NOT stop just because you now have all three wheels on the ground...

As long as your blades turn (whether you taxi or not) you must be aware of the wind.

CHIPPER says

Remember this subject before you fly again as it can make a huge difference to the safety of your future flights.
